CHILDREN'S MINISTRY Volunteer Positions

SUNDAYS

Kid Check Helpers (9:30 & 11:15)

- Greet parents and children
- Assist parents with Kid Check

Door Greeters (All Services)

- Greet parents and children
- Ensure that only those with check in stickers enter
- Make sure parents and children leave together

Teachers (All Services)

- Prepare a lesson from curriculum
- Teach the lesson
- Send the children home to parents with matching sticker numbers
- Clean up the room

Helpers (All Services)

- Help the teacher in any way needed
- Send the children home to parents with matching sticker numbers
- Clean up the room

Baby Holders (All services)

- Hold and play with babies
- Change diapers as needed
- Serve bottles and/or snacks
- Send the children home to parents with matching sticker numbers
- Clean up the room

Hall Monitor (9:30 & 11:15)

- Make sure children get to the bathroom or water fountain and back to class
- Be available to stand in a class for a moment as a helper
- Help late comers get checked in and to their class

Kids Church Team Guide (9:30&11:15)

- Read over the small group activities
- Greet kids as they arrive
- Participate with your group in all the large group activities
- Lead the small group activities for your group

Kids Church Story Guide (9:30 & 11:15)

- Prepare by reading over the lesson provided for understanding and familiarity
- Teach the lesson

Kids Church Worship Leader (9:30&11:15)

- Choose songs
- Practice songs
- Lead songs

Kids Church Song Helpers (9:30&11:15)

- Practice songs
- Help lead songs

Kids Church Techs (9:30 & 11:15)

- Know the sound, lighting, and computer systems
- Run the tech during kids church

Buddies (Sundays and Wednesdays)

- Be willing to be assigned to a child who has special needs
- Help the child be a part of the children's program by staying with them and participating with them
- Retreat to designated quiet area if needed



WEDNESDAYS (September-May)

Childcare Providers (Babies – 2-year-olds)

- Hold and play with babies
- Change diapers as needed
- Serve bottles and/or snacks
- Send the children home to parents with matching sticker numbers
- Clean up the room

AWANA Director

- Lead the Preschool, K-2, or 3rd-5th age group.
- Have all supplies ready for rooms
- Prepare and teach the Bible lesson
- Oversee the leaders for each room

AWANA Leader

- Oversee the helpers in your room
- Keep the achievement records for the clubbers in your room
- Award the clubbers as they work through their books
- Work with Director to make sure your group has all it needs

AWANA Game Leader

- Pick and prepare games from handbook
- Lead game time with assigned group of children
- Encourage fun and good sportsmanship

AWANA Helper

- Greet kids as they arrive
- Listen to verses that kids have memorized and mark off in book
- Encourage those who need to still memorize verse

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- Be willing to be assigned to a child who has special needs

Preppers

People who can serve by prepping crafts and projects for Sundays or special events.

Decorators

People with an eye for what looks good and can come in and decorate for a new theme or a special event.

Organizers


People who love to make it all fit and for it to be labeled.
